

Worthington Hills Consumer Supported Agriculture (CSA) with



CSAs are an excellent way for community members to support local growers, to learn more about the growing process, and to enjoy fresh, healthful, chemical-free produce throughout the season. This is one of the best things you can do for your health and the health of the earth!

Worthington Hills neighbors joined together last year to purchase shares and the farmer delivered right to our neighborhood! We are ready to do it again and want to invite you to join in the fun and health!

This year, we will be using Wayward Seed Farm in Marysville. This is their 3rd year doing the CSAs and Adam has grown up farming. If you purchase a veggie and fruit share, you get to take 5% off your total. You can split one or both types of shares with another family and still take the discount. When you consider the cost over 25 weeks for the veggie share (20 weeks for the fruit), you will see what a great value this is for your family!

Please review the forms on the back for specific options and plans to suit your needs. You can send forms directly to the farm at the address listed.

Starting in June and continuing through November, shares will be delivered to the neighborhood on Wednesdays around 4:00 pm. You can pick up your share anytime that evening at the Hetterscheidt's at 1133 Blind Brook Dr.

As with most CSA programs, the quantity you receive will vary from week to week. Listed below are a few of the vegetables you can expect during the growing season.

Consider this list only a small portion of what will be available. As usual, we are experimenting with new varieties and may include them in your weekly share. Here are examples of a two person vegetable share and when to expect what fruit:

June 21

½ lb. Mesclun Mix
1 bunches Chioggia Beets
1 bunches Kinko Carrots
2 lbs. Summer Squash
1 bunches Hakurei Turnips
10 Squash Blossoms
½ lb. Sorrel
1 lb. English Peas
½ lb. Swiss Chard

September 20

½ lb. Lettuce Mix
½ lb. Arugula
1 bunch Turnips
1 Kabocha Squash
1 bunch Watermelon Radish
2 lbs. Green Mountain Potatoes
1 lbs. San Marzano Tomatoes
½ lb. Mixed Sweet Peppers
2 Eggplant

June: Strawberries, Cherries, Red Raspberries

July: Cherries, Red Raspberries, Blueberries, Peaches

August: Blueberries, Peaches, Apples, Melons, Plums, Nectarines, Red Raspberries, Grapes

September: Peaches, Apples, Red Raspberries, Melons, Watermelons, Plums, Pears

October: Apples, Pears, Red Raspberries, Grapes, Quince

The farm will be accepting a limited number of members and shares will be granted on a first come, first serve basis. A letter of confirmation will be sent following the receipt of payment. If you are participating in both the fruit and vegetable programs, please subtract a 5% discount from your payment.
