

## WHCA Meeting Minutes October 11, 2006

Call to Order: 7:07 P.M.

**Attendance:** Chet Chaney, Cheryl Garrett, Chief Robert L. Oppenheimer, Officer Gordon T. White, Jim Reardon, Tom Schwing, Karen Kramer, Carol Prosser and Doug Curran.

**Secretary:** Minutes from the September meeting were read and approved.

**Treasurer:** Brian Clark submitted via email a report detailing expenditures and income as of October 1. The report was approved.

**Police: Perry** – Chief Oppenheimer reported an ongoing domestic violence situation on Blindbrook. He said that the police visit there a couple times a day and that charges have been filed. He also reported that the township's police runs will be placed online in the next few months. Lastly, he mentioned the upcoming levy and magnet delivery, which should start on October 28.

**Sharon** – Officer White reported incidents of telephone harassment, speeding (largely by out-of-town relatives of Hills residents), and a case of a "jump the curb" hit-and-run accident where the offender made the mistake of leaving his vehicle's license plate on the damaged premises.

**Resident Relations:** Chief Oppenheimer and Officer White would like the Association to send their respective departments any name and address information on new residents.

### **Community Activities:**

**Red Cross Blood Drive** – Jim indicated that this event is on schedule for November 27.

**First Aid/CPR Class** – Jim reported that then people have signed up.

**Food Drive** – Cheryl indicated that this drive runs from November 8 until December 20, which is the last day of school before the break at Worthington Hills Elementary. Hills Market will match

donations made there. The food collected prior to Thanksgiving will go to St. Francis of Appalachia. As for donations made after Thanksgiving, two-thirds will go to St. Michael's and one-third to the Open Shelter.

**2007 Summerfest Planning** – Cheryl mentioned that a local radio station is showing interest in sponsoring July 4<sup>th</sup> activities and that perhaps it would also be interested in this event.

**Views from the Hills:** Doug reported that he is obtaining price estimates from three printing companies for future issues of the newsletter.

**Web Site:** Chet indicated that estimates for site design ranged from \$1,600 to \$8,000. He will invite the low bidder to the November meeting.

**Database:** Karen requested that the member database be placed on an online server that board members could access.

**Grounds & Maintenance:** Chet reported that landscaper Tom Woods has a proposal for replacing the pulled-out trees. He also reported that the Association has money budgeted for some new Christmas decorations, but that lighting design work will have to wait until next year due to budgetary constraints.

**Government Relations:** Tom reported that Ohio American Water Company is in the process of replacing ten fire hydrants in the Hills.

**School Relations/Scholarships:** No report.

**Zoning:** No report.

**Old Business:** None.

**New Business:** Cheryl indicated that the Worthington Hills Country Club needs address labels to mail promo flyers for various upcoming events. On behalf of a resident, Carol asked if Sharon Township has a zoning officer. Chet referred her to Franklin County.
