

## WHCA Meeting Minutes December 13, 2006

Call to Order: 7:00 P.M.

**Attendance:** Cheryl Garrett, Officer John R. Thomas, Constable Gordon T. White, Bonnie Smith, Scott Smith, Jim Reardon, Tom Schwing, Frank De Lucia, Doug Curran, Robin Hawken and Matt Dopkiss.

**Secretary:** No report.

**Treasurer:** Cheryl distributed copies of both Treasurer Brian Clark's list of monthly income and expenditures and the proposed annual budget for 2007, which will be voted on at the January meeting.

**Special Issues:** Doug reported that in typing up an electronic copy of the civic association's Code of Regulations, he found some inconsistencies, poor wording, etc. He proposed that the Code be revised at the annual members meeting in April. Hard copies of proposed revisions were distributed to board members.

**Police: Perry** – Officer Thomas reported the following incidents: misuse of a credit card on Blindbrook, vandalism on Oakbourne, cruelty to animals on Clubview North, a two-car accident on Clubview North, a domestic assault on Clubview South, theft and impound of bicycles where the thief stole one bike and left another, and telephone harassment (estranged husband calling ex-wife) on Clubview North.

Bonnie and Scott Smith elaborated on the cruelty to animals complaint, which they filed, and related incidents.

**Sharon** – Constable White reported that from December 1 through 13 the township made 73 community checks, 63 vacation house checks, two traffic citations and one criminal complaint of felony importuning and pandering via the Internet from a house on Mission Hills. The accused man no longer lives in Worthington Hills. Neighbors will be notified should he move back in. Sentencing is scheduled for December 14.

**Resident Relations:** Cheryl reported that she and Carol plan to propose a membership drive strategy at the January meeting.

**First Aid/CPR Class** – Jim recommended that we hold off on scheduling another CPR class until this summer.
